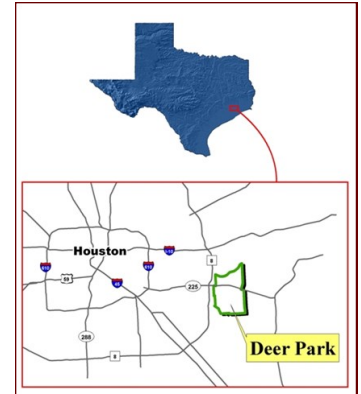

So, why the “Birthplace of Texas”? Deer Park is the site of the Battle of San Jacinto and where the peace treaty was signed in 1836, allowing Texas to win its independence from Mexico.

Deer Park has grown into a friendly, convenient community located in southeast Harris County, only 25 minutes from downtown Houston. Deer Park was named "**Best Affordable Suburb in Texas for 2010**" by Bloomberg BusinessWeek, "**#10 Among Top 25 Cities in the U.S. for Affordable Homes**" by CNN Money in 2011, and awarded a contender spot on the CNN list of "**100 Best Places to Live**" in 2011 and 2009. The city provides easy access to the Houston region, Clear Lake/Bay Area and the sand and surf of Galveston Island. It is also home to The Battleground at Deer Park Golf Course (**rated #1 golf club in Houston area "Under \$30"** by the Houston Chronicle).



Deer Park named #1 Best Affordable Suburb in Texas

Deer Park was recently awarded Bloomberg-BusinessWeek's annual award for the "Best Affordable Suburb" in Texas for 2010. The award was given after comparing 15 Texas suburbs using a matrix of various measures like the cost of living, home value, average income, transportation, services, schools, quality of life, crime rates, etc. Deer Park was given high marks for green space, low crime rates, short commute times and the high quality of our school district.
